

# HOW TO USE POWER PACKS at Your Family Math Night Event

**1**  
**choose**

one of the games you would like your participants to play at your event.

**2**  
**choose**

the strategies/tools that you would like participants to use with your chosen game. These can be found by looking at the number listed after the game directions.

**3**  
**set out**

the game and strategy/tool cards. Decide how many participants you would like at your station and set out that many of the game and strategy/tool cards. Be sure the game pieces are also set out.

**4**  
**provide**

pencils and scrap paper.

**Note:** Since there are 10 games in each Power Pack level (K-1, 2-3, and 4-5), it is possible to set up several Power Pack game stations like the one above.

## Take-Home Power Packs:

Sending home a Power Pack with students after your Family Math Night event is a good way to encourage skill practice at home. There are two easy ways to do this:

1. After participants have played the games at the station, have the Station Facilitator hand them their very own Power Pack which they get to take home.
2. Hand the Power Packs out to participants as they leave the event.
