

Use the following check-list to make sure your child has all the tools needed for success in math.

Pencils - at least two!

Pencil sharpener - just in case.

Eraser - because it's okay to make mistakes when we're learning!

Scratch paper - also called thinking paper!

Counters - about 50 of anything small...beans, buttons, beads...

Tape measure - for when things are longer than I2 inches.

Centimeter/inch ruler - for measuring length.

Compass - the kind for drawing circles.

Protractor - when you need to measure angles.

Graph paper - for area and perimeter problems.

Calculator: a fun way to check your work.

Shoe box or large ziplock bag - a place to keep everything organized.
